### As you prepare for worship... Proper 29B

**Isaiah 53:10:11:** This is a familiar passage from the Good Friday Liturgy. The Prophet proclaims that it is God's will that His Servant (whom we see as Jesus) suffer as an offering for sin. Victory will not come in his (human) lifetime but future generations will remember His sacrifice. Because He is righteous in His self-offering, He will make "many" righteous and bear their iniquities.

**Hebrews 5:1-10:** The (unknown) author has proclaimed Christ as our High Priest, who, rather than offering someone else as a sacrifice for sin, allowed Himself, according to the will of the Lord, to be sacrificed. Just as Aaron was appointed by God (the first High Priest) so God, at His baptism, appointed Jesus as High Priest. Unlike other High Priests, however, Christ is a priest for ever. Melchizedek was a Canaanite priest who brought bread and wine to Abram, not unlike the meal Jesus gave us to remember His cross and resurrection.

**Mark 10:35-45:** The disciples are having a hard time understanding Jesus' view of power – they have argued as to who was the greatest, they complained because someone was casting out demons in Jesus' name (which they could not do), now two disciples come right out and ask a favour of Jesus: to sit at his right hand and his left in his kingdom. Jesus repeats himself that among the Gentiles power is used over and against people. "Not so among you," He says. We are to serve one another as He Himself served us.

### A NEW DIOCESAN POLICY

States that anyone involved in the following ministries must be fully vaccinated as of 31 October: all Licensed Lay Readers, all liturgical leaders including, but not limited to, organists and choir directors, choristers, musicians, lectors, intercessors, Eucharistic Administrators, wardens, greeters and servers over 12 years of age, all Sunday School teachers and youth leaders and all pastoral visitors.

If you are involved in any of the above ministries please bring in your proof of vaccination to Valerie (Mon-Fri, 9-1). Those who are medically unable to be vaccinated must obtain a written doctor's note exempting them from this vaccination requirement. They will be required to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken less than 72 hours before the time they are scheduled to serve in their ministry role.
