### As you prepare for worship... Easter 4B

Acts 4:5-12: In last Sunday's reading, we heard that when Peter and John went to the Temple to pray, a crippled man was healed in the name of Jesus. The now healed man then walked and leapt and praised *God*, and entered the Temple with them. The next day (today's reading) the Sanhedrin assembled and had John and Peter stand before them. In fulfillment of Jesus' prophecy that the Holy Spirit will give us the words to say, Peter addressed them and told them that it is by the name of Jesus that the crippled man was cured. Invocation of Jesus' name has put the forces of evil to flight. In verses following our reading, John and Peter tell the Sanhedrin forthrightly that they will continue to spread the good news about Jesus, whatever the cost to them.

**1 John 3:16-24:** Jesus is the great example of selfless love: far from taking life, he "laid down his life for us." John asks us "How can the love that originates in God be in a wealthy person who sees another in need and refuses to help?" We need to love *actively*, and not just "in word or speech." Since we know we are following God's ways, we can boldly ask God for any spiritual benefit and He will grant it! (*Filled with the Holy Spirit, we would never ask* for anything "worldly" or frivolous, and so God grants the request)

John 10:11-18: Jesus, addressed the Pharisees, called himself the good shepherd (strongly implying that they are not!). Being the good shepherd, he would die to save his sheep. But the hired hand (the Pharisee) does not care enough to save the sheep from the wolf. Jesus' relationship to his people is like the Father's to him. Then Jesus speaks of "other sheep" who must be brought into the sheepfold? (Hey! That's us!) "They" will have equal status with those who already follow Jesus, as part of one Church. Then Jesus told them that he has been given the authority to choose to die and the power to rise again from the dead. He is in control of his own death and resurrection.
