As you prepare for worship...Easter 5C

Acts 14:21b-27: Paul and Barnabas were commissioned (chapter 13:1-3) through the Holy Spirit and by the elders of the Church in Antioch to travel throughout the region to preach the Good News of Jesus Christ in Jewish synagogues. Both Jews and Gentiles heard the message (they stayed awhile in these towns and word about their message spread beyond the synagogues). In our reading today, with their work fulfilled, they gathered the whole Church in Antioch to tell them the surprising news: that God "opened a door of faith" even for the Gentiles! So typical of God to take the little we do and bring about great things.

Revelation 21:1-6: John the Divine was given a vision of what will occur at the end of the current age. In his vision heaven and earth were destroyed and only the Godly remnant remained. In our reading today John wrote that he saw the new creation and the new Jerusalem, descend from heaven. It will be as lovely as a bride, he wrote, and in it God will dwell with His people. Sorrow death and pain will be no more for God will make all things new. To those who thirst, God gives the water of eternal life.

John 13:31-35: Jesus had been trying to prepare his disciples for his "departure" (death, resurrection, ascension) from them. The Father had been revealed in Jesus ("God has been 'glorified' in him") so much so that when one sees Jesus, one sees God. He concluded by commanding them to love one another as he had loved them (the OT Law states that believers are to love one's neighbour as oneself) and that by this love their genuine discipleship will be revealed.
