As you prepare for worship... It's all about the Kingdom of God today!

Daniel 7:1-3, 15-18: Daniel had a vision that terrified him regarding four beasts. An "attendant" told Daniel that evil world powers will be overcome by God, who will grant His holy ones (those whom God calls) to receive the Kingdom of God, against which no evil can prevail, for ever and ever.

Ephesians 1:17-23: Paul wrote to a group of new Christians, whose faith is so strong that Paul heard of it. Paul prayed that as they come to know God that God will bless them with both "wisdom" (through experiences of God) and "revelation" (seeing God in their lives). Paul used the word "saints," commonly referring to both believers and those who have passed on. All of this is from God whose power was revealed when He raised Christ, seated him in heaven and made him head over all things for us, the Church.

Luke 6:20-31: The Kingdom of God is for those who know their poverty before God, who hunger for God. Those who are "full," who are rich in the world's ways and spend their lives laughing without a care toward God or anyone else, will find themselves on the outside. Kingdom life is marked by love of enemies, goodness even to those who hate us, and generosity.
