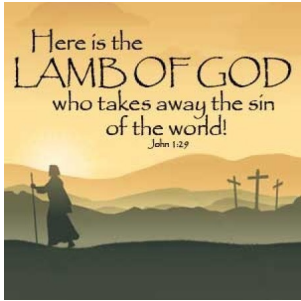

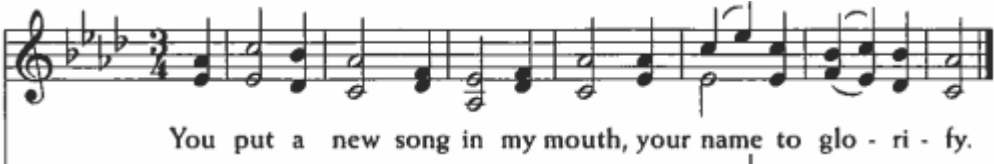

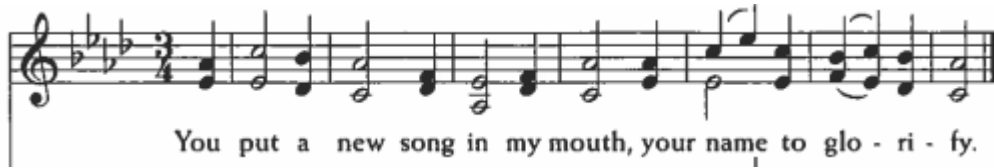
I waited patiently for you, O God;

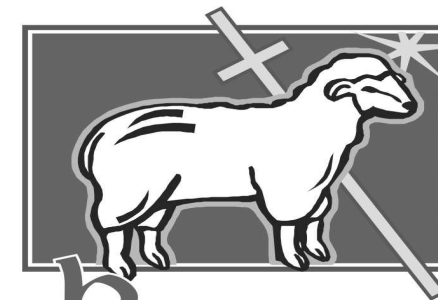
