

As you prepare for worship...Proper 5A

Isaiah 58:6-10: The people of God have accused God of not caring for them and not listening to their prayers. They complained that this is not fair because they worship God correctly and are observing the Law. (It's almost as if they think God "owes" them!) We hear God's response: basically their worship is insincere, they have not integrated what they hear into their lives which is shown in how they mistreat one another. The Lord says that this is true worship: to treat one another, and the needy in our community, with the love and help they hope from God.

1 Corinthians 2:1-12: Paul continued his teaching on the cross of Christ. He wrote that the fact they have come to believe is because of God, because, Paul wrote, he was weak and afraid when he first started preaching in Corinth. He ended by reminding the Corinthian Christians that the same Spirit of God that motivated them to faith now dwells within each of us.

Matthew 5:13-20: We continue with the Beatitudes, teachings from a Kingdom of God perspective. Jesus told these poor, spiritually abused people that they really are salt (of incredible value) and light! They are encouraged to live lives that reflect our heavenly Father. In this way, his followers will have a righteousness that exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees.

Next weeks readings: Exodus 24:12-18; 2 Peter 1:16-21; Matthew 17:1-9


